This island is off the coast of the northern part of The North Island, so we were in no danger, since we live on the western side of New Zealand. Please pray for those affected by this tragedy.

We are praising the Lord for believers willing to share Christ with others. Last month, we shared how Regan accepted Christ after the faithful witness of a friend, and then recently another family from Auckland was burdened for their nephew and drove down to New Plymouth to share Christ with him.
