Greetings from the UK.

Marriage life is great. I married Deana Hewston on September 23, and if anyone wants to watch the wedding, it is up on the front page of my website Calebfielding.com (You can also find all my past prayer letters and statement of faith there). I have prayed for decades that God would provide me a helpmeet, and God has certainly answered the prayer with Deana. During our honeymoon, we visited Perth and noticed a Jehovah's Witness family handing out their literature. We tagged teamed, giving them the Gospel. I dealt with the husband, and Deana dealt with the wife. When all was said and done, we took the couple through dozens of verses showing the deity of Christ and the truth of the Trinity, as JW's deny this. The wife was very unhappy with the conversation and ended it, but I was able to give the husband my business card. Please pray that he gives me a call so I can take him through more scriptures. His name is Christopher, and he and his family need to trust Christ.

Deana was serving in Scotland, but after we married, we managed to pack all of her things and move her down to England with me. Because my place is so small, we had to put her things in storage, and began immediately to search for a new place to live. We found a place a mile or so away just off the High Street in Huntingdon and signed the lease. We move on November the 24th... Black Friday, so keep us in your prayers.

Now that Deana and I are married, we are working on getting a spousal visa for me. Since Deana has been in the UK for seven years, she has a long-term stay visa and can sponsor me for the visa. One of the documents we needed for the visa was a lease with both of our names on it, and so with the signing of the lease the other day, we sent all our documents to the lawyers and are waiting to hear back from them. Please pray that the spousal visa is approved quickly and without headache. We ask that Deana's supporting churches continue to send her support to CMC until I have the spousal visa as the UK government considers CMC to be her employer. We will let you know when that changes.

Due to our wedding and honeymoon, I spent about a month and a half away from the ministry in England. Now that I am back New Testament survey will be starting the life of Paul. Also, in the coming months, Deana and Laura Bangs plan on starting an after-school Bible club. We have other ministries we are researching and praying about starting, but until the spousal visa is approved, we are not making any concrete plans.
