JANUARY AND FEBRUARY 2021 PRAYER LETTER



We were under lockdown since the beginning of January here in Québec, so all of our services were held online. Because of that, we took the opportunity my wife and I to start a young couples class that we do on Microsoft Teams every Friday night after the kids are in bed. The response was good and we have 7 couples that are logging in every Friday. Its a 12 weeks class, and my wife and I have also profited from it greatly. Pray for those couples that they would have a thriving marriage as they follow Christ.

On Sunday Night, we also have a doctrinal growth group that meets online as well. We are studying the different core doctrines a believer should understand and believe. What an enriching time, where people can ask questions and exchange while learning the Bible.

Thankfully, last Sunday, we were able to welcome people back in the Church Building. We are so excited to have people back at church, and it was wonderful to worship our God together. Our building was packed with around 50 people, which is, with social distancing, our full capacity. There were many children, and with the space that we have right now, its becoming a challenge. We are praising God for His Church that He is building. All the glory belongs to Jesus!!

Our lease is up on the building we are renting, and we are looking at different possibilities to expand. One of these possibilities, is right under our feet. While talking with the owner of the building, I mentioned to him that we would love to expand in order to have a larger seating capacity, a place for kids to safely play outside, have room for kids classes and a fellowship area. He mentioned that the place under us could be available. The inside is a 30'X40' building with 14' of ceiling height. We could build a staircase that connects both spaces from the inside. We would relocate the kids ministry downstairs and arrange for a fellowship area. The upstairs would be used for the Sanctuary and my office. This would push our seating capacity(with social distancing of 6 feet) to 70. The owner would be willing to level the dirt outside to create a green area for the kids to play as well. It's funny because we thought of that option before, but just assumed that the owner would never let go of this space. Of course this involves a bigger lease payment, and renovations expenses, but we know that where God leads, He will provide. Could you please pray with us about this opportunity, as we need to give him an answer soon. Though the times are uncertain, we are looking at the future, and trusting God for the increase. Sometimes you have to launch out into the deep...

We did celebrate a very special birthday last month, my wife. I am so thankful for the wife God gave me. Her heart for people, her Godly wisdom, her irresistible smile and her joyful attitude are only a few of the reasons why I love her so much.
